Notes

1. About Gift Aid

Under the Gift Aid legislation registered charities such as SIFD can reclaim tax in respect of qualifying donations received, increasing the value of donations. These donations can include membership subscriptions received from an individual member who has completed a Gift Aid Declaration. For a claim to be valid the person making the payment and the Declaration must have paid UK Income Tax of at least the amount recoverable, in the year for which the claim is made.

2. Do I need to contact HM Revenue & Customs?

You do not need to contact HM Revenue and Customs, unless you are a Higher Rate Taxpayer and wish to claim relief against higher rate tax. If this applies to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue & Customs to adjust your tax code.
